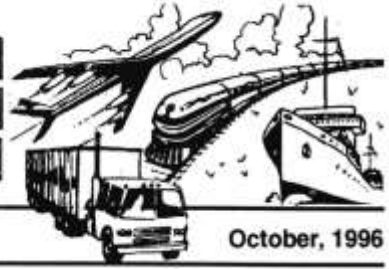

A Look into the Archives – 1929

Crash ?? What Crash ???

Even on the heels of the great stock market crash of October 1929, The Traffic Club of Cleveland was still ready to party.

December 16th, 1929 you are commanded to appear in the Court of Common Pleasure.

The guest speaker, Mr. Barnett R. Brickner was a rather prominent man. An ordained Rabbi from Hebrew Union College, he was very influential in the Jewish faith founding and leading many Jewish organizations and leading congregations as a Rabbi.

Brickner debated attorney Clarence Darrow at the Masonic Auditorium on "Is Man a Machine?" in Feb. 1928. Between 1928-36, he was a labor arbitrator. Brickner succeeded Rabbi ABBA HILLEL SILVER as president of the BUREAU OF JEWISH EDUCATION (1932-40), and in 1935 cochaired with Silver the reorganized fundraising Jewish Welfare Fund. Brickner was also the president of the Cleveland Zionist District, the local branch of the Zionist Organization of America.

No mention is made of the meal, but I'm sure it was in the tradition of all Traffic Club functions, both good and plentiful.

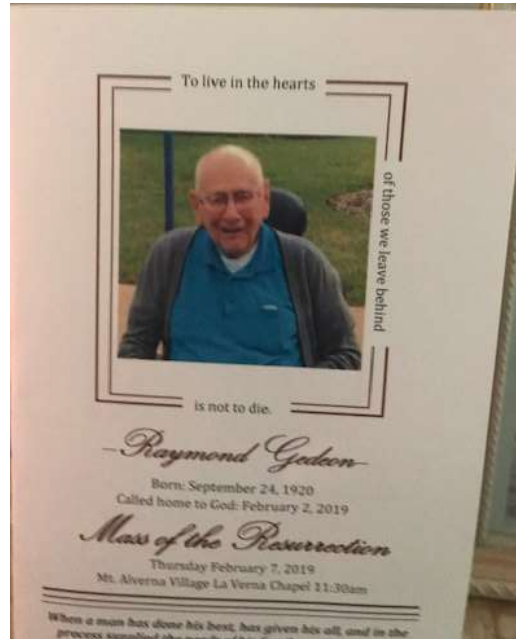
